


One Book One Nebraska 2008

One Book One Nebraska 2008 is a great opportunity for Nebraska libraries to invite their communities to participate in a community-wide experience of reading together and sharing ideas. We invite libraries to advertise and promote this reading activity and to create events to bring this opportunity to the community. Library staff, volunteers, and supporters are key to helping people across the state celebrate and explore the work of Nebraska's State poet William Kloefkorn by reading his book, *Restoring the Burnt Child: A Primer*, and by participating in discussions and local community events throughout Nebraska. We hope that residents of Nebraska communities will come to know each other better by reading together and discussing this fine coming-of-age story, with relevance to diverse people of many backgrounds.
